
OSHAWA N.A.S.C. Hockey Annual Christmas Tournament HOUSE LEAGUE TOURNAMENT PLAYING RULES

DECEMBER 27 – 29, 2019

- 1. ALL O.M.H.A. RULES WILL APPLY. All players must wear a mouthguard.
- 2. Approved House League roster sheets must be submitted to the Tournament Committee before the first game. All players must be on an O.M.H.A. or similar governing body roster sheet, submitted to the Tournament Committee, to be eligible for play.
- 3. No application fees will be refunded after December 13, 2019.
- 4. NO PLAYERS can be added to a team under any circumstances for this tournament.
- 5. <u>All teams must be prepared to start all games fifteen minutes prior to their scheduled game</u> <u>time</u>. If not ready, a TWO-MINUTE PENALTY MAY BE ASSESSED. This is to ensure the schedule is maintained.
- 6. Referees decision is FINAL.
- 7. <u>NO protests will be permitted</u>.
- 8. ALL FIGHTING MAJORS SHALL result in IMMEDIATE SUSPENSION from the TOURNAMENT.
- 9. All round robin games will consist of three ten (10) minute stop time periods. If the game is prolonged through excessive game stoppage, the buzzer will sound to end the game. All preliminary round robin games adhere to a curfew. This is to allow all games to start on time and eliminate delays. There is no curfew for final round playoff games.
- 10. If there is a five (5) goal or greater spread, in the third period, the clock will be allowed to run. If the spread becomes less than five (5) goals, the time clock will revert to stop time. This applies in Round Robin and Semi-Final rounds only.

THIS APPLIES TO ALL AGE GROUPS

- 11. Ties count in round robin game play (no overtime).
- 12. Ties in round robin standings will be broken as follows:
 - 1. Winner of game between tied teams
 - 2. Least goals against
 - 3 Least penalty minutes (3 game series total)
 - 4. "Goals for" divided by "Goals against" (according to Game Sheets)





13. Overtime in Championship games, will consist of one (1), five-on-five, five (5) MINUTE SUDDEN DEATH PERIOD. At the end of the 5 minutes, if no winner has been declared, there will be a shootout.

Before each Championship game the coaches are required to list on the game sheet, the first five (5) players for the shoot-out in the order they are to shoot. Players will be lined up on their respective benches in the order that the coaching staff has identified on the game sheet. Shootout will be conducted by referee instruction and both players will go upon the signal of the referee.

Both players will leave the centre ice circle upon signal of the referee. In the event that the score is still tied after the first five (5) selected players have gone, the coach then selects a new player for each next shot and shootout play then becomes sudden death.

<u>Note:</u> The original 5 players identified on the game sheet prior to the start of the game, CANNOT be re-used unless all players listed on the game sheet have been used.

If a player who has been identified on the game sheet prior to the game is in the penalty box at the end of the game's overtime period, and the Referee determines that a shootout is required, the player(s) in the penalty box are ineligible to participate in the shoot-out and alternate players must be provided by the coach prior to the commencement of the shootout.

- 14. One (1) thirty (30) second time-out is permitted in final round championship games only.
- 15. The tournament committee reserves the right to make decisions regarding the interpretation of the tournament rules. ALL DECISIONS ARE FINAL.
- 16. Any player assessed a 3rd penalty in a game, the player will be ejected for the remainder of the game.
- 17. Any team found playing an ineligible player will forfeit any points earned in the game, and shall be reported to their league executive and the O.M.H.A. As a result, the Head Coach will be suspended from further tournament play.
- 18. Payment of any damage caused to facilities will be the responsibility of the offending team. The tournament, Oshawa N.A.S.C. Hockey, Arena Staff and Management will not be responsible for any injuries, damages or thefts that may occur during the tournament.
- 19. There will be absolutely NO Tolerance of any form of abuse towards any game, league and/or tournament committee member or official. Such acts will be dealt with immediately and may result in the team being removed from the event.
- 20. Any concerns/complaints are to be discussed with the N.A.S.C. Hockey Tournament Chair, N.A.S.C. Hockey 1st Vice Chairman and/or N.A.S.C. Hockey League Registrar. Dependent upon the issue at hand, a 24-hour "cooling off period" may be invoked by the Tournament Committee and no further discussion will be permitted.

THERE IS NO BODY CHECKING IN ALL DIVISIONS. PLEASE NOTE: It is your responsibility to get a dressing room key.

<u>NOTE:</u> Please advise your team spectators there will be NO gate fees and they will be allowed to access the arenas at any time to watch games.

While every effort will be made to have all divisions the same, sometimes-unforeseen circumstances force the tournament committee to make changes.
